Day 1	Fly Nairobi

Day 1

Today you will check in for your overnight flight to Nairobi, Kenya.

Day 2

On arrival you will be met and transferred by charter aircraft to Shompole, where you will stay at Shompole Lodge for 2 nights on a full-board basis.

Shompole is an exclusive and beautiful lodge on the edge of the Nguruman escarpment, overlooking the Great Rift Valley. Constructed from natural white quartz stone, pale thatch and indigenous wood, and using water as a prime feature, each suite provides a very spacious, shady oasis in this green desert environment. Each of the six rooms has a cool-pool and informal sitting area, a bathroom with a view and a specially designed, mosquito netted, sleeping tent which includes vast windows and a high canopied roof. Activities include early morning and evening walks, night drives, sundowner visits to Lake Natron to see the flamingos, picnics and nights spent out in romantic fly-camps. It's a beautiful lodge and even though there is plenty to do you probably want to leave your room, it's just so relaxing and such an amazing view.



Day 4

Today you will be transferred to the airstrip from where you will fly by charter aircraft to the Masai Mara. You will be met on arrival and driven to Naibor Camp where you will stay for the next 3 nights.

Naibor Camp is set on the banks of the Talek River within the world famous Masai Mara Game Reserve, and has six spacious canvas tents each with a shady veranda, en-suite bathroom with flush loo and shower, king-size bed and big sofas. The tents, which make the most of the surrounding views, nestle amongst a riverine forest and with their solid comfortable furniture offer the ultimate in camping-luxury to come back to after exciting game drives or walks in the conservancy. Activities include day and night game drives guided by professional guides, bush walks, fly camping, overnight walking safaris and long walking safaris. You can also visit the OI Kinyei Masaai to learn about their culture, old and way of life.



Day 7

Today you will be transferred back to the airstrip from where you will fly to Lewa Downs. You will be met on arrival and transferred to Wilderness Trails where you will stay for 3 nights.

Lewa Downs is one of Kenya's original ranches and has been the Craig family home since 1924. It is now a beautiful protected game area and home to a number of endangered species, and you can enjoy game drives, bush walks, horse-riding, camel treks and fishing. There are eight beautifully decorated luxury cottages, featuring fireplaces and verandas, with en-suite bathrooms and Will and Emma will welcome you into their home to sit by the fire. Nearly all the food is home-grown, and the skilled chefs transform the home-raised livestock and a 5-acre organic garden, into healthy and delicious meals.



Day 10

Today you will be transferred to the airstrip where you will check in for your scheduled flight to Nairobi where you will connect with your scheduled flight to Lamu. On arrival in Lamu you will be met and transferred by road and boat to Manda Bay where you will stay for 6 nights on a full-board basis.

Manda Bay is on the North-Western tip of Manda I island, one of the many unspoilt, idyllic islands in the romantic Lamu archipelago. It lies in calm inshore waters on a long sandy protected beach with miles of soft white sand, fascinating creeks and small islets to explore. With 10 cottages constructed from local materials, it is a beautiful retreat for both family groups and honeymooners. The lodge has its own private, fully fitted 60foot traditional dhow which can be chartered for day cruises, and other activities include windsurfing, laser sailing, water skiing, creek fishing, massage, mangrove trips, scuba diving and day trips to Lamu Island.



Day 16

Today you will be transferred back to the airstrip for your scheduled flight to Nairobi where you will connect with your flight back to the UK.
