Brief Itinerary



Day 1	Fly to Livingstone, Zambia
Day 2	Road transfer to Tongabezi, 3 nights FB
Day 5	Fly Mfuwe, stay Kafunta Lodge River Lodge, 2 nights FB
Day 7	Game drive to Island Bush Camp, 2 nights FB
Day 9	Game drive to Kafunta River Lodge, 1 night FB
Day 10	Fly Lilongwe, road transfer to Danforth Lodge, 4 nights FB
Day 14	Fly home

Day 1

Today you will check in for your overnight flight to Livingstone in Zambia.

Day 2

On arrival in Livingstone, you will be met and transferred to Tongabezi, where you will stay for 3 nights on a full-board basis.

Tongabezi is one of the most romantic places to stay in Livingstone. A small, secluded lodge set in a grove of African ebony trees, it has unique open-front-open-plan houses and five luxury cottages. At Tongabezi, you can relax by the pool or go walking, canoeing or boating and it is ideally placed to enjoy all the activities at the Victoria Falls.



Day 5

This morning you will be transferred to Livingstone Airport, where you will take a scheduled flight to Mfuwe, the gateway to the South Luangwa National Park. You will be met on arrival and transferred by road to Kafunta River Lodge where you will stay for the next 2 nights on a full-board basis.

Kafunta River Lodge is a classic safari lodge set in riverside forest on the banks of the Luangwa River, overlooking the South Luangwa National Park. The eight private chalets are built on raised wooden platforms under a thatched roof, with mahogany floors and walls giving a natural feel to the luxurious interiors. There is a swimming pool and you will enjoy great game viewing and bird watching from the lodge.



Day 7

This morning you will be driven through the park, enjoying a game drive on the way, to Island Bush Camp, where you will stay for the next 2 nights on a full-board basis.

Island Bush Camp is two hours' drive south of Kafunta River Lodge, and is set in a very remote, game-rich area of the southern section of the park. It lies under a grove of mahogany trees on the only habitable island in the Luangwa River, and has grass and reed huts, with hot showers and running water, and a private veranda overlooking the Luangwa River. It offers a more rustic experience, and is really special. Walking safaris are the speciality here.



Day 9

This morning you will return to Kafunta River Lodge where you will stay for one more night on a full-board basis.

Day 10

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Mfuwe Airport for your scheduled flight to Lilongwe, where you will be met and transferred by road to Cape Maclear on Lake Malawi to stay at Danforth Lodge for the next 4 nights on a full-board basis.

Danforth is an up-market, owner-run guest house at Cape Maclear on the shores of Lake Malawi. It has four spacious, en-suite family-size rooms, tastefully decorated in cool, nautical colours and all opening onto a large patio. It has shaded gardens and is just a stone's throw from the beach where you can go sailing, cruising, snorkelling, diving and windsurfing among other activities.



Day 14

Today you will be transferred by road to Lilongwe where you will check in for your overnight flight back to the UK via Johannesburg.
