

Kenya: Immerse yourself in Africa



Brief Itinerary

Day 1	Fly Nairobi, Kenya
Day 2	Fly Nanyuki, Sosian Ranch, 3 nights, fully-inclusive
Day 5	Karisia Walking Safari, 3 nights, full-board
Day 8	Fly Amboseli, Campi ya Kanzi, 3 nights, fully-inclusive
Day 11	Fly Diani, Msambweni Beach Villas, 4 nights, half-board

Day 1

Today you will take the international flight to Nairobi, Kenya.

Day 2

On arrival in Nairobi you will take the scheduled flight to Nanyuki and transfer to Laikipia to stay at Sosian for the next 3 nights.

Sosian, the Samburu word for the wild date palm, is a lovely ranch house set in 24,000 acres of working cattle farm and wild bush located in the vast Laikipia plateau in central Kenya. The area is home to a wide diversity of wildlife and birds, including four of the Big Five, as well as a host of other large mammals, including cheetah and the rare wild dog. One of the best ways to experience the African bush is on a horse and Sosian is a wonderful place for horse-riding, providing horses for all levels of riders.



The ranch house was originally built in the 1940s by Italian artisans, and has seven double cottages in the grounds. Sosian Ranch is a great place to unwind and just experience the wilderness, enjoying different kinds of activities including clay pigeon shooting, guided bird walks and fishing. As well as riding safaris, you can experience the bush on a walking safari with the lodge's knowledgeable guides, look for the nocturnal animals of Sosian on a night game drive or explore the bush on camel back. The more adventurous can head to the waterfalls on the Ewaso Narok River and jump into a big pool of water 30 feet below.



You will spend 3 nights at Sosian Ranch on a fully-inclusive basis.

Day 5

Today you will be transferred to Karisia Walking Safaris where you will embark on a 3 night adventure.

Specialised in Walking Safaris, Kirisia offers clients a unique opportunity to discover the most pristine regions of Kenya by foot, to explore Kenya's magnificent wildlife up close and to get to know the rich culture of the Samburu warriors in an intimate and authentic environment.



Escaping the constraints of a vehicle means that you can walk where no cars can go. You will be led by professional guides, which are fluent in English, Swahili and Maa and extremely knowledgeable in natural history and local culture as well as in how to provide an adventure of a lifetime. Every safari is tailor made to suit different interests and every day is unique. The classic safari uses large dome tents fitted with sheets and blankets, pillow, towel and a solar light with shared toilets. Riding camels accompany walkers.



You will spend 3 nights on a Karisia Walking Safari on a full-board basis.

Day 8

Today you will be transferred to the local airstrip and fly to the Chyulu Hills to stay at Campi ya Kanzi for the next 3 nights.

Campi ya Kanzi lies in a 400 square mile group ranch, owned by Masai herdsman. Situated just next to Amboseli National Park and bordering Tsavo West and Chyulu National Parks, the camp provides a unique opportunity to experience the real African wilderness on walking safaris with Masai warriors. Stretching from the Chyulu Hills to the foothills of Mount Kilimanjaro, the variation and the vastness of the area means you can enjoy most of the different environments of Kenya, including mountain forest, grasslands, river woodlands, bush and savanna, and the incredible biodiversity and wildlife that inhabit these environments. Being outside the National Parks means you have the total freedom to walk, it's a truly unforgettable experience going on an early morning walk with a Masai tracker, looking for the cheetah or leopard.



There are six tented cottages and two luxury tented suites all with different views. They all have a wooden floor which stretches out into a veranda, and an elegant en-suite bathroom, with brass taps, bidet, basin, shower, flush toilet and hot and cold running water. Tembo House is the thatched hub of the camp, where you will enjoy Italian meals and where you can relax with a book from the library,

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play backgammon or simply enjoy one of the many views of Kilimanjaro, Taita Hills and the Chyulu Hills from the huge veranda.



You will spend 3 nights at Campi ya Kanzi on a fully-inclusive basis.

Day 11

Today you will fly to the coast to Diani and will be driven south to stay at Msambweni Beach Villas for the next 4 nights.

Msambweni House is a wonderful family-owned hideaway on Kenya's south coast. It is one of the more luxurious options in this area, and enjoys a quiet, unspoilt setting with its own private stretch of beach. Set high on a cliff, it has three master rooms and an ocean suite in the main house, and three private villas, as well as a fantastic 25 metre infinity pool. The three spacious en-suite rooms in the main house are decorated in classy Swahili style and finished with pure white linen. The rooms all have a Lamu bath, shower, king-size beds, satellite television, air-con, free minibar, hairdryer, mosquito nets and a private terrace.



You will spend 4 nights at Msambweni Beach Villas on a half-board basis.

Day 15

Today you will be transferred to Mombasa where you will check in for your flight home.
